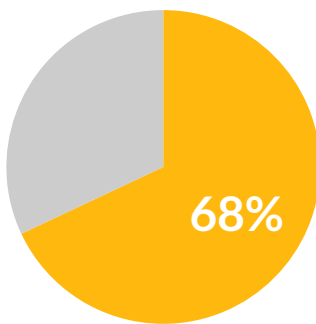
Critical Skills: STEM Exploration

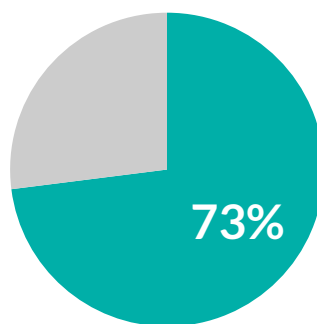

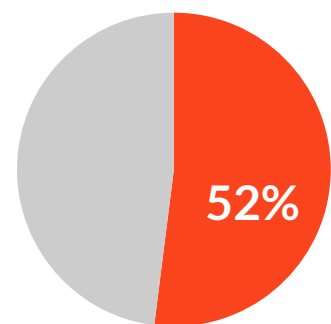

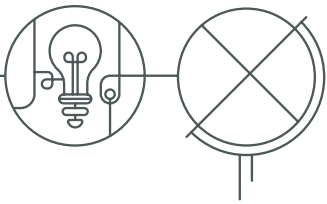

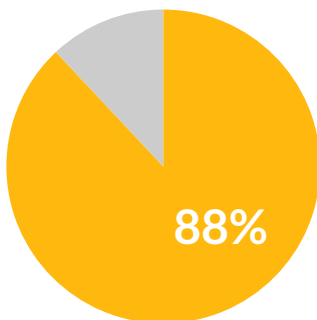

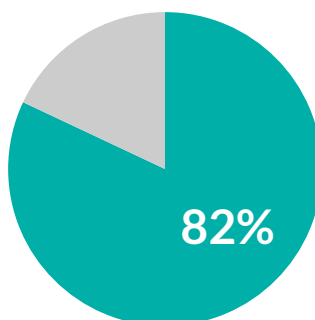

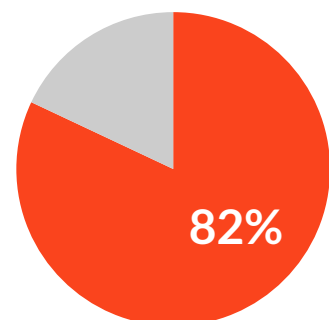

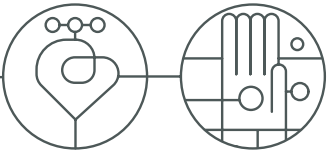
I talk to my family about my community.

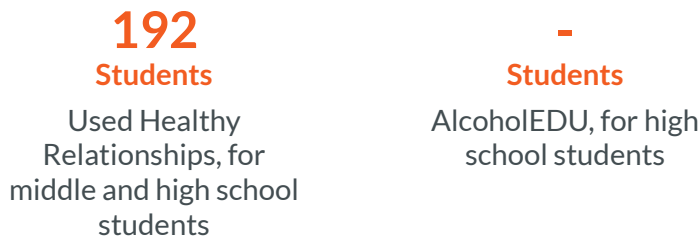


Critical Skills: Health & Wellness
